DISD Junior High School Game Day Protocols VB & BB

Athletic Travel

- All students will ride with their teams to the games with DISD provided transportation.
- All <u>Remote Learners</u> will need to be at <u>their campus</u> by 3:30 on game days.
- Any student who wants to ride home with their parents must complete an alternative travel form and follow all DISD regulations to ride home with their parents. (Parents/Guardians ONLY)
- Students who ride home with their parents will be allowed to carry <u>ALL</u> of their belongings on the bus, as long as they can hold it on their lap.

Competitions in the Gym; Volleyball & Basketball

- Seating Capacity is reduced to 50%.
 - Campus will receive a mockup of the seating and will have to mark the seats.
 - Capacity for spectators Kranz-158
 - o McAdams-200
- All spectators must complete a Health Self-Assessment and sign in prior to entering the gyms.
- All spectators must wear masks except when eating and drinking.
- All spectators must socially distance themselves (6 feet) from others/groups.
- Spectators must be at least 10 feet away from the teams.
- All athletes/Coaches must follow UIL and DISD athletic protocols.
- Concessions may be sold as long as all items are pre-packaged by a restaurant, i.e. Chic fil A sandwiches, pre-packaged pickles, sodas, water, chips, candy, microwave popcorn, etc.

Gym Sanitizing

- After each game, they gym should be cleared of spectators for bleacher sanitation.
- Bleacher sanitation will be done and scheduled with your campus custodial staff.
- Volleyballs and Basketballs should be sanitized before the second game by a member of the coaching staff.

Between Games

- All spectators will exit the building between games and re-enter to allow for cleaning.
- Teams may warm up during this time.
- Spectators who stay for the second game will need to be counted as part of the seating capacity for the second game.
- It will be encouraged that members of the first game be allowed to leave with their parents.
- If members of the first game remain for the second game, they must be counted for seating capacity.

Game Day Ticket Process

- GAMES AT Kranz and McAdams WILL BE FREE OF CHARGE.
- Each athlete will be permitted the opportunity to purchase 2 season passes for their parents **FOR CCISD GAMES**ONLY!!
- Passes will be created by the athletic department and delivered to the bookkeeper.
- These passes will only be available as a one-time opportunity, Monday, September 21 through Wednesday,
 September 23. PASSES ARE \$6.00 for DISD PARENTS!
- The number of passes sold will be reported to the Athletic Department.
- The Athletic Department will notify the bookkeeper of how many tickets will remain to be sold each week.
- The number of passes sold from both teams will be deducted from the gym's seating capacity.
- Available tickets to be sold will be paper, \$2.00 for adult and \$1.00 for student, first come, first serve basis.
