

# Summer School

## 9 Day Session & Virtual Session



### Session A: 9 DAYS IN JUNE

**Registration is Monday, June 3rd in Gator Mall from 8–3.**

- \* Breakfast (8 AM) & Lunch are provided at no additional charge.
- \* Transportation is NOT provided.
- \* Class hours are 8:30 AM to 3 PM
- \* Cost is \$100—Cash, no checks. Credit card use is available for an additional \$2 processing fee.
- \* No absences are allowed. However, if a student completes their course early, they do not have to continue to attend.
- \* All courses will be done through online Edgenuity program.
- \* Initial credit courses will only be approved by the student's counselor if the student's formal 4 year plan requires summer school to complete requirements. Initial credit options will include fine art, PE, and Spanish 2. Additional courses available for seniors on an early graduation plan are: English IV A/B, Government, Economics
- \* The dates are Tuesday, June 4th through Friday, June 14th.

### Session B: VIRTUAL SESSION

**Registration is Monday, June 3rd in Gator Mall from 8–3.**

- \* Virtual session is ONLY available for students who participated in the June session.
- \* Cost (\$100) and initial credit rules are the same as above.
- \* This session is done fully at home and requires internet access and a computer. Edgenuity is not compatible with mobile devices so it cannot be done on a cell phone.
- \* We will provide a lab in D hall for support on the following days: 6/18, 6/25, 7/9, 7/16, 7/23, & 7/30 from 9-noon.
- \* The final/cumulative exam must be taken in the lab on campus at one of the days listed above. The course and exam MUST be completed by 7/26 to receive credit. There will be no extensions.
- \* The dates are Tuesday, June 18th through Tuesday, July 30th.
