Session Title	Session Description
Grade Level Meetings (9th, 10th and 11th grades)	Please attend the grade level meeting that applies to your student. Find out about what is coming up for that grade level as well as what to expect next school year. PSAT scores will also be discussed.
HELP! My kid is graduating in May! What do I need to know? (12th grade)	All seniors and parents are asked to attend this session. We will discuss important information about prom, graduation, and project graduation.
Beware what you share: Social media safety (9th-12th grades)	As a parent of a teenager, you know how tech savvy kids are these days. Learn about some of the risks of social media use, ways to monitor your child's online activity and some general tips and tricks for keeping everyone safe while online.
My kid is an athlete! How can they play in college? (NCAA) (9th-12th grades)	Student who plan to play sports in college must register with the National Collegiate Athletic Association. Learn how to register with the NCAA.
Earn college credit in high school! Tell me how! (9th-11th grades)	Did you know students can start earning college credit in 10th grade at DHS and possibly earn an associate's degree while in high school? Find out about Dual Credit, new Dual Credit Workforce Programs, Collegiate High School, and AP classes. Parents/ students interested in Dual Credit must attend this session.
Gator Scholars (By Invitation)	This meeting is for families of students who were invited to participate in Gator Scholars based on PSAT scores.
Pathways to Adulthood (By Invitation)	Find out about services from outside agencies that are available to your student.
Summer School Now Registration (9th-12th)	Students who need to recover a credit from 1st semester were given information regarding the new Summer School Now Program. Learn more about the program and register your student.
SAT Registration (11th)	DHS will offer the SAT to Juniors during the school day on April 23rd. Registration will be held from January 31– Feb 15 DURING LUNCHESES in the Counseling Office. Students/ Parents may also register <u>during Parent University in D101</u> . Cost: \$10 (\$5 if on free lunch program).
