

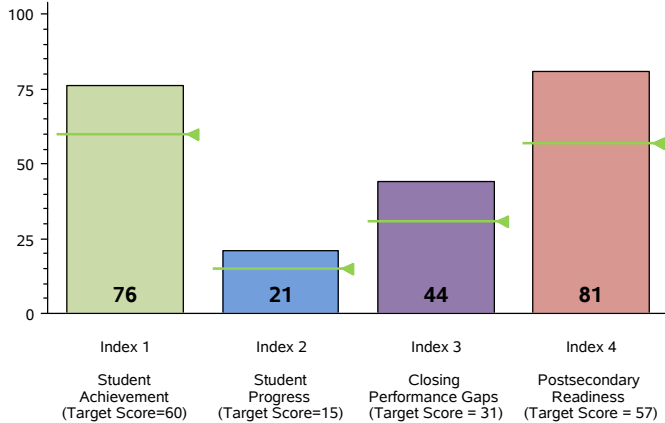

### 2015 Performance Index
