Medical Terminology Syllabus 2020-2021

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to introduce students to the structure of medical terms, including prefixes, suffixes, word roots, and combining forms in their singular and plural forms, in addition to medical abbreviations and acronyms. The course allows students to achieve comprehension of medical documented vocabulary appropriate to human anatomy, physiology, pathophysiology, medical procedures, and medical equipment.

EXPECTATIONS

Throughout this course students will be expected to show respect, integrity, and encouragement to everyone around them. They will be expected to come to class on time and ready to actively participate with daily lessons. They should ALWAYS be ready to do their best. Over the course of the semester I expect my students to develop a set of skills and a sense of professionalism expected of them in the healthcare industry.

Grading Policy

- ❖ Formative Assessment (Daily Assignments & Quizzes): 50%
- ❖ Summative Assessment (Test & Projects): 50%
 - ❖ There will be a weekly quiz over: A set of medical terms (20-30 terms/week)
 - ❖ A weekly disease including its diagnosis, signs and symptoms, and treatment.
 - ❖ There is a zero tolerance policy for cheating and/or disruptions during a test or quiz. A student suspected of cheating or creating a disturbance during a test or quiz will result in ZERO for that assessment.

Late Work & Make-Up Work

- ❖ **Late Work:** Any daily activity or homework assignment turned in late by the student can be made up within a 3 school day period with 10 points deducted for each day late. No work will be accepted after the third late school day resulting in a zero in the grade back.
- ❖ **Make-Up Work:** It is the responsibility of the student who is absent, to check the "make-up work folder" containing the assignments they missed. Students will be given one day, per day absent, to make-up the assignments they missed, after that the assignment will be considered late. Extenuating circumstances will be give special consideration.
- ❖ Extra Credit cannot be given to "bring up" a failing grade.



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Special Considerations

- ❖ The student must have successfully completed Principles of Health Science prior to entering Medical Terminology.
- ❖ Please be on time, wearing their ID badge, and in dress code. Students will not be allowed to enter the classroom late, without an ID, or out of dress code without an entrance slip from an Assistant Principal's office.
- ❖ Students will also be expected to follow proper social distancing practices, donning of face covering, proper and frequent hand hygiene and other preventative measure to prevent the spread of COVID-19
