The scene must have:

Characters the people who through their words and actions tell the story of the play (use a maximum of one and a maximum of four characters).

Dialogue the conversation of the characters that reveals their ideas, emotions, and desires.

and how the set/lights/sound/props/costumes should look (use a minimum of five stage and how page).

Setting the location of the play (use one location only).

Time when the play takes place; the era, period, season, and time of day (use one time span only; no time change).

Plot the story of the scene (be sure the plot is easy to follow and interesting).

Theme your message; the moral or the lesson about life the main character learns.

Style the genre or type of play (stick to comedy, tragedy, or social drama).
