Green: Great day, did what was expected. Yellow: Fair (five minutes out at recess) Orange: Oops (ten minutes out at recess)

Red: Note to parent or parent phone call and 15 minutes loss of privilege and possible isolation into another teacher's classroom (repeat visitors)

Repeated offenses will result in the principal being contacted.
