## Class Expectations

Always be...

#### Absences

It is the student's responsibility to ask for make-up work! I have already added "extra time" to each rotation. Late Assignments (No Absence Involved) This is NOT "Make Up" Work - Only Summative grades are allowed to be readministered. Late work, even if it stacks up, are not allowed to be turned in after the Module is completed. Remember, each rotation already has about 3 days of extra time. A total 20 points are deducted for any late work that is accepted before the grading period or module rotation ends.
