## SILBERNAGEL ELEMENTARY CAMPUS PLAN 2021-22

### **GENERAL CAMPUS PROCEDURES**

- Hand sanitizer will be available at the main entry to the campus, in classrooms, in the cafeteria and common areas throughout the building.
- **Students, staff and visitors are encouraged to wear masks while in the building.**
- **To provide for physical distancing, visitors will not be permitted in the cafeteria during mealtimes.**
- Food deliveries **are not permitted**. If a student forgets to bring a lunch from home, a meal will be provided by the cafeteria staff.

# ARRIVAL

## STUDENT ARRIVAL - BUS

### CAMPUS PROCEDURES:

- Students will enter the back doors near the bus circle. Pre-K and kinder students will go to the cafeteria.
- First through fourth grade will go to their pods.

### STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

- **Students should not receive fever-reducing medication before coming to school in the morning. If a student has fever, he/she should remain at home.**

## STUDENT ARRIVAL - CAR RIDER

### CAMPUS PROCEDURES:

- At 8:00, the campus will allow students to enter the building
- **Students who arrive before 8:00 must wait in their car.**
- Parents must remain in their vehicle.

### STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

- **Students should not receive fever-reducing medication before coming to school in the morning. If a student has a fever, he/she should remain at home.**
- Pre-K & Kindergarten students will report to the cafeteria.
- First through fourth grade students will report to their pods.

## VISITORS

### CAMPUS PROCEDURES:

- All individuals who have COVID-19 symptoms, or are lab confirmed with COVID-19, must remain off campus until the criteria for re-entry is met.
- Visitors **are not permitted** to join students for breakfast and/or lunch.

# MEAL TIME

## BREAKFAST

### CAMPUS PROCEDURES:

- Students will eat breakfast in the classroom.
- All students eat breakfast free of charge.

### STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

- Students will be expected to follow breakfast procedures - sanitizing hands before/after eating and cleaning their area when finished eating
- Visitors are not permitted to eat breakfast with their child.
- Food deliveries are not permitted.

### TEACHER EXPECTATIONS:

- Teachers will monitor students during breakfast.

## LUNCH

### CAMPUS PROCEDURES:

- Two classes eat lunch in the cafeteria and four classes eat in the classrooms. Subject to change if COVID cases decrease.
- Visitors are not permitted during lunch.
- Food deliveries are not permitted.

### STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

- All students wash hands or use hand sanitizer before and after eating lunch. All students follow cafeteria procedures.

# BUILDING

## RESTROOMS

### CAMPUS PROCEDURES:

- Proper handwashing techniques will be taught to students the first week of school.

### STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

- Students must wash hands after using the restroom.
- Students should follow restroom rules.

## **HALLWAY**

### **CAMPUS PROCEDURES:**

- Minimized movement throughout the building.
- Water fountains are shut off. Students need to bring a water bottle, with their name on it, every day. It will go home every afternoon to be washed. Water bottle refilling stations are available.
- Classes will follow the traffic pattern when moving throughout the building.

### **STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:**

- Students will follow campus guidelines for hallway behavior.

## **CLASSROOM**

### **CAMPUS PROCEDURES:**

- Students do not share school supplies.
- Follow procedures for hand sanitizing throughout the day.
- High-touch areas in the classroom are wiped between activities.
- Hand sanitizer in every classroom and pod.
- Technology is used and sanitized.
- Frequent hand washing/sanitizing throughout the day.
- Outdoor space may be used for learning.

### **STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:**

- Students will wash/sanitize hands before entering the classroom.
- Students will receive training in proper hygiene procedures.
- Parents need to check their child's temperature every morning before sending them to school.
- Students will not share materials.

## **RECESS/AUXILIARY CLASSES**

### **RECESS**

#### **CAMPUS PROCEDURES:**

- All students will sanitize hands before and after recess.

### **MUSIC, ART, TECHNOLOGY & LIBRARY**

#### **CAMPUS PROCEDURES:**

- Teachers and students will sanitize hands before class begins and when it ends.
- Equipment is sanitized after use.

- Students will go to the auxiliary classroom for instruction.

## **P.E./TECHNOLOGY**

### **CAMPUS PROCEDURES:**

- Equipment is sanitized.
- Students will sanitize their hands before/after class.

# **DISMISSAL**

## **BUS RIDERS & DAYCARE**

### **CAMPUS PROCEDURES:**

- Bus riders will remain in their classroom until their bus is called. Staff members will escort students to their bus.
- Students will exit through the back cafeteria doors.
- Daycare students will wait in the cafeteria.
- Daycare students are escorted by staff through the back cafeteria doors to the daycare van.

## **WALKERS**

### **CAMPUS PROCEDURES:**

- Walkers will exit the door near the gym.
- Staff members will escort the students down the sidewalk and across the street.
- Parents must show their walker sign, with their student's name, to staff members prior to students being released.

## **CAR RIDERS**

### **CAMPUS PROCEDURES:**

- Parents follow car rider procedures.
- Parents remain in their vehicle.
- Staff supervise students and assist them with getting into their vehicle.
