

GALENA PARK I.S.D. STADIUM RULES & REGULATIONS

Welcome to Galena Park I.S.D. Stadium. We are excited that you chose our stadium for your game. It is our hope that you will find our facility safe and enjoyable, where we can all appreciate and applaud the efforts of each group.

Listed below are the rules and regulations we ask that you follow while in our facility. We do appreciate your observation of these guidelines:

- Gates will open 1 hour prior (or earlier for playoffs) to game time for spectators. Home gates are located in the northwest corner of the stadium. Visitor gates are located in the southeast corner of the stadium.
- 2. Spectators will not be allowed to leave the stadium and return once the game has started; unless they have a valid reason.
- State laws and school district policies will be in effect concerning alcoholic beverages and controlled substances.
- No outside food or drink may be brought into the stadium; this does not apply to band, drill team or cheerleaders.
- 5. Food, drinks, gum, sunflower seeds and tobacco are prohibited at all times around or on the field areas.
- 6. The use of tobacco products in any form is prohibited on all school district property. (State Law)
- 7. Tailgate parties are prohibited.
- 8. Only emergency vehicles may be parked inside the stadium. No vehicles of any kind are allowed to drive on the field surface; including trailers and golf carts.
- 9. No loitering will be permitted. Spectators must sit in the stands and keep off the rails. Aisles should be kept clear at all times. **Students may not cross to the other side of the stadium.**
- 10. Items such as Frisbees, balls, whistles, skateboards, baby powder, silly string, ballons, mechanical noise makers, air horns etc. are not allowed in the stadium.
- 11. Backpacks, coolers, etc are not allowed in the stadium. Clear bags only.
- 12. Umbrellas cannot be used in the seating area, courtesy of fan viewing and safety.
- 13. Victory lines shall be limited to drill team and cheerleaders only.
- 14. Only authorized personnel will be allowed on the field or in the field house area before the game, at halftime, or after the game. Individuals must present a sideline pass. Each school is responsible for their sideline.
- 15. **Coaches' wives and families** are not allowed on the field after the game. They may visit in front of the locker room by going through a small gate by the ticket booth.
- 16. Booster clubs may sell items under their own grandstand; however, Galena Park I.S.D. Athletic Department must be notified in advance. Please call 832/386-4330 to arrange for tables and chairs.



GALENA PARK I.S.D. STADIUM INFORMATION FOR SPECTATORS, PARENTS AND FANS

Directions/ Parking: Galena Park I.S.D. Stadium is located at 15025 Wallisville Road on the east side of Houston. Wallisville Road is located north of I-10 on Beltway 8. Exit Wallisville and turn west.

The visiting team will **enter the stadium off of Wallisville Road**, past Walgreens and the Y.M.C.A. (there are two entrances available).

Ticket Booths:

Open 1 hour prior (1:00) to the start of the game (Playoffs 1 and a half prior)) The home ticket booth is located at the northwest corner of the stadium and the visitor ticket booth is located in the southeast corner of the stadium.

Rules:

- (1) No outside food or beverages allowed.
- (2) No coolers or backpacks allowed. Clear bags only.
- (3) No umbrellas allowed in the stands.
- (4) No smoking or tobacco use in or around the stadium.
- (5) Law prohibits firearms and weapons of any kind.
- (6) To re-enter the stadium, you must purchase another ticket.
- (7) No spectators are allowed on the field at any time.
- (8) Please keep the aisles at the concourse level and areas around the concession stands clear.
- (9) No standing or loitering in the concourse level and areas near the concession stands.
