

Dickinson ISD Residency Affidavit process for 2020-2021

As part of the Back to School process each year, all students are required to submit a new proof of residency verifying that they live in Dickinson ISD. This can be done by providing the school with a current lease or mortgage statement or an electric, gas or water bill. The proof of residency must be in the name of the student's parent or legal guardian.

If the parent or legal guardian is unable to provide one of the proof of residency documents above with his or her name, then a residency affidavit is required before a student can register or attend school in Dickinson ISD. The person that the family lives with must go through a residency affidavit process which includes completing paperwork, providing required documentation and getting a form notarized.

RESIDENCY AFFIDAVITS FOR NEW DICKINSON ISD STUDENTS:

Beginning Monday, June 15, new Dickinson ISD students, including those entering pre-kindergarten or kindergarten or students who are moving to Dickinson ISD from another school district, may complete the residency affidavit process.

Packets can be picked up anytime during summer office hours of 7:15 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Thursday starting June 15. Completed packets may only be returned from 8-10 a.m. Mondays and Wednesdays starting June 15 through the remainder of the summer to the district's Education Support Center, 2218 FM 517 East. The district will be closed the week of July 6-10.

RESIDENCY AFFIDAVITS FOR RETURNING DICKINSON ISD STUDENTS:

Beginning Monday, July 13, returning Dickinson ISD students can complete residency affidavits. Packets can be picked up anytime during summer office hours, 7:15 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Thursday. Completed packets may only be returned from 1-3 p.m. on Mondays and Wednesdays starting July 13 through the end of the summer to the district's Education Support Center, 2218 FM 517 East. For those already on a residency affidavit from last year, there is a shorter renewal process if nothing has changed with the living situation.

If a returning Dickinson ISD student was not on an residency affidavit last year and circumstances have changed that now require the affidavit process, the family must complete the entire process like new students above.
