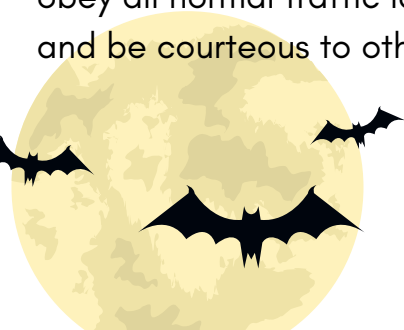
UIL notices will start going home sometime in October. Practices will start the last week of October or the first week of November. Encourage your child to try out!

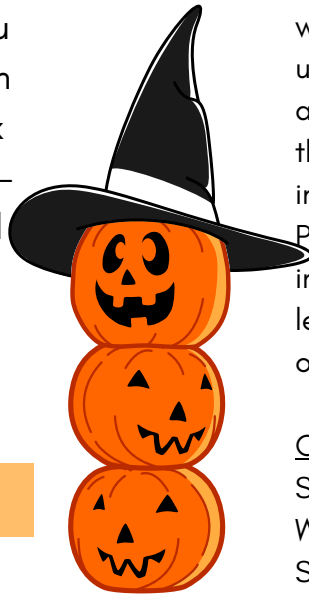
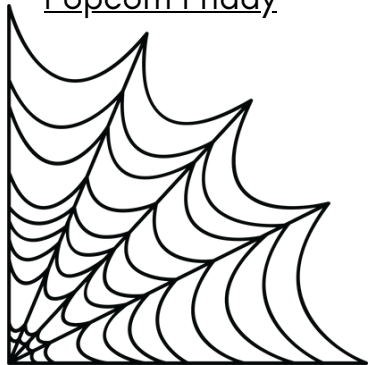
