**\*\*We will not be accepting lunch reservations on Friday November 15th.\*\***

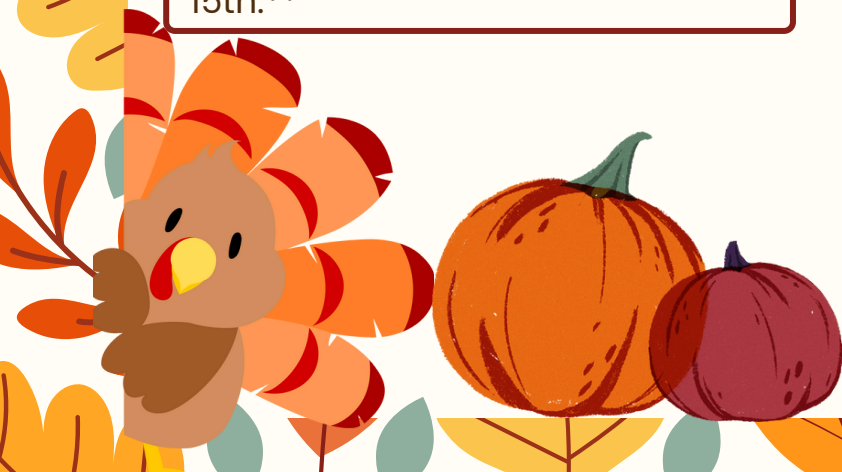
## Cafeteria News

### 2nd Grade Music Program

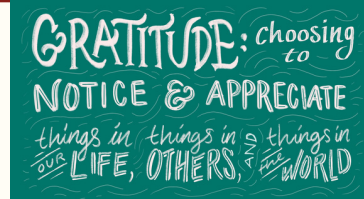
