Tells how **YOU** feel.

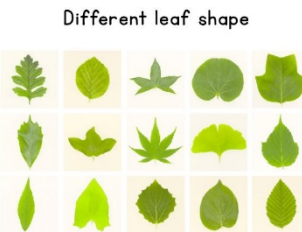
